

NEW ENGLAND ASSOCIATION OF MATHEMATICS LEAGUES

The thirtieth annual New England Math Team Competition was held on May 2nd, 2002 at Canton High School, Canton, Massachusetts. Fifty Schools from all New England States except Vermont competed for both team and individual awards.

Schools were invited because they were the champion of their individual league or finished in the top three or four places in their respective State Tournament.

The NEAML competition is divided up into three divisions according to a school's enrollment in grades 10-12. The LARGE school division consisted of 16 schools whose enrollment is greater than 850 pupils; MEDIUM division had 19 teams and enrollment is between 450 and 850; SMALL school division had 15 teams and each school has less than 450 pupils. Schools in the LARGE division compete with eight members on a team while six person teams comprise the teams from the other two divisions. There are six individual rounds each consisting of three questions. The categories are: arithmetic, algebra I, geometry, algebra II, analytical geometry, and trigonometry and complex numbers. Students have 10 minutes to answer the three questions. The final round of twelve minutes is the team round and all team members
